MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Art.1 Parties

1. **ROCBC Suceava** under which it works Joint Technical Secretariat of the JOP "Romania-Ukraine 2014-2020", located in 8A, Bistritei Street, 1st floor (DAE Centre), Suceava, Suceava County, Romania, represented by Mrs. Marcela SLUSARCIUC, Executive Director and Mrs. Ingrid BUCSA, Head of the Joint Technical Secretariat.

2. **Agency of Sustainable Development and European Integration "Lower Danube Euroregion"**, located in Ukraine, Odesa region, Izmail 68600, Svyato-Nikolska str., 1, represented by Mr. Igor BABAIAN, Head of administrative council.

Agreed on the following provisions:

Art.2 Object

The object of collaboration is represented by the dissemination of information on the Joint Operational Programme Romania – Ukraine 2014 – 2020 towards the local communities, authorities, institutions, civil society and other relevant actors from the eligible area of the Programme, covering:

- in Romania – Suceava, Botosani, Satu-Mare, Maramures, Tulcea
- in Ukraine – oblasturile Zakarpatia, Ivano-Frankivsk, Odessa, Chernivtsi,

The memorandum of understanding does not represent a business relationship, but a relationship between two organizations which involves the development of joint activities in the benefit of the partners and of the Programme, respectively of the local communities that these address to.

Art.3 Rights and obligations of the collaborators

The Joint Technical Secretariat of the Joint Operational Programme Romania-Ukraine 2014-2020

1. It provides its collaborator with information and promotion and publicity materials regarding the Programme.
2. It invites its collaborator to take part to information and promotion actions developed under the Programme.
3. It coordinates the activity related to the dissemination of information on the Programme in the eligible area.

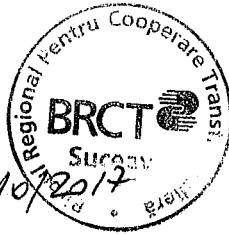
1. It disseminates information on the Programme towards the organizations registered in its own database and with the help of on-line communication channels that it has subscribed/ registered to.
2. It distributes the information and publicity materials on the Programme provided by the JTS to the actions/ events that it takes part to.
3. It posts on its own website the information sent by the JTS.

Art.4 Final provisions

1. The parties will reach a common agreement on the actions to be taken in order to implement the present memorandum.
2. Any modification to the present memorandum will enter into force only with the prior agreement of all the parties.
3. Any eventual disputes resulted from the present memorandum or related to it, that the parties cannot solve in an amiable manner, will be subject to the competent courts.
4. The parties agree on the fact that the present memorandum is governed by the Romanian law in force.
